



Craft corner:

Robot toothbrush holder

Do you want your own Riley Robot? Follow these directions to have fun making one. Then “program it” to hold your toothbrush.

Here’s what you need

- 1 recycled jar
- Green acrylic paint
- White acrylic paint
- 2 large googly eyes
- Black acrylic paint
- A grown-up to help
- Glue stick

Here’s how to make one

1

Have a grown-up help you wash and dry the jar.

2

Paint the outside of the jar green.

3

Glue the googly eyes in place.

4

Use the black and white acrylic paints to color a mouth like Riley’s.

5

Use the black acrylic paint to add eyebrows.

6

Be creative! Use lids, buttons, pipe cleaners or other recycled materials to make the robot your own.
